He is the Chairman of the World Economic Forum's Global Advisory Council on Innovation and is known for his practical approach to "getting innovation done" — which is the topic of his presentation on May 8.

Heidi Grant Halvorson – An expert on motivation and achievement, Ms. Halvorson's research lies in understanding how people respond to setbacks and challenges and how these responses are shaped by the types of goals individuals pursue. She is the Associate Director at the Motivation Science Center and will speak on May 9 about what successful people do differently.
